

Decision Subject: Concurrence on Proposed Modified Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Sierra Waste Recycling and Transfer Station, SWIS No. 34-AA-0214

Action By: June 22, 2013

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Branch Chief take action on a proposed modified Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Sierra Waste Recycling and Transfer Station, SWIS No. 34-AA-0214, located in Sacramento County. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The proposed permit was received on April 11, 2013. A new proposed permit was received on April 23, 2013. Action must be taken on this proposed permit no later than June 22, 2013. If no action is taken by June 22, 2013, the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed permit.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Branch Chief concur with the issuance of the modified permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685 have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Permitting & Assistance Branch Staff Report attachment. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Staff Report.

Branch Chief Action:

On the basis of the information and analysis in this Request for Action and the findings set out in the Permitting & Assistance Branch Staff Report, I concur in the issuance of the modified Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Sierra Waste Recycling and Transfer Station as proposed.
