Decision Subject: Concurrence on Proposed Modified Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Southeast Resource Recovery Facility (SERRF), Los Angeles, SWIS No. 19-AK-0083

Action By: September 29, 2015

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Branch Chief take action on a proposed modified Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Southeast Resource Recovery Facility (SERRF), SWIS No. 19-AK-0083, located in Los Angeles County. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The proposed permit was initially received on December 31, 2014. To address deficiencies in the Report of Station Information, the operator waived the statutory timelines on February 11, 2015 to August 10, 2015. A new proposed permit was received on July 31, 2015. The operator again waived the statutory timeline on August 5, 2015 to August 31, 2015. Action must be taken by September 29, 2015. If no action is taken by September 29, 2015, the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed permit.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Branch Chief concur with the issuance of the permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685 have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report attachment. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report.

Branch Chief Action: On the basis of the information and analysis in this Request for Action and the findings set out in the Permitting & Assistance staff report, I concur in the issuance of the proposed Modified Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the SERRF, SWIS No. 19-AK-0083, as proposed.
