Please be advised that the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), acting as the Solid Waste Enforcement Agency (EA) for the County of San Luis Obispo, has received an application to modify the Solid Waste Facilities Permit (SWFP) for the Camp Roberts Landfill. On August 28, 2015, the EA found the permit application complete and correct and is in the process of preparing a proposed SWFP to include the changes listed below. This public notice was prepared pursuant to Title 27, California Code of Regulation (27 CCR), Section 21660.3.

**Project Description**

A review of the SWFP issued on June 7, 2010, found that the actual disposal area is less than the permitted disposal area specified in the SWFP. The proposed modifications include the following:

- Decrease the overall permitted disposal area from 17.6 to 13.34 acres; and
- Incorporate an update Joint Technical Document as the Report of Facility Information.

There are no changes to the permitted hours, tonnage, or material types accepted.
