

**Decision Subject:** Concurrence on a Minor Waste Tire Storage Facility Permit for Wally's Tires & Wheel

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**Summary of Request:** This is a request that the Program Director approve the renewal of a Minor Waste Tire Storage Facility Permit for Wally's Tires & Wheel, Fresno County – Facility TPID No. 1002817. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.


Staff received an application for a Minor Waste Tire Facility Permit on March 22, 2010. The application was accepted on May 17, 2010. CalRecycle is required to act by November 12, 2010.

**Recommendation:** Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends issuance of the permit. The applicant has met all the necessary application requirements outlined in 14 CCR, section 18431 pertaining to the issuance of a Minor Waste Tire Facility Permit. This facility has been in operation prior to January 1, 1990 and has undergone no substantial changes in design or operation. Therefore, staff has determined that permitting this facility does not require a CEQA analysis, pursuant to PRC 42812. The documents and analysis on which staff's findings are based are in the facility file.

On the basis of the information, analysis and findings in the staff report attached to this Request for Action and staff recommendation, I hereby issue the Minor Waste Tire Storage Facility Permit for Wally's Tire & Wheel, TPID No. 1002817.
