


Summary of Request: This is a request that the Program Director approve the issuance of a Minor Waste Tire Storage Facility Permit for Recycle Depot, Kings County –TPID No. 1622736. Staff’s findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

Staff received an application for a Minor Waste Tire Facility Permit on July 21, 2010. The application was accepted on August 4, 2010. CalRecycle is required to act by January 31, 2011.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends issuance of the permit. The applicant has met all the necessary application requirements outlined in 14 CCR, section 18431 pertaining to the issuance of a Minor Waste Tire Facility Permit. The required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Waste Compliance and Mitigation Program Staff Report attachment. The documents and analysis on which staff’s findings are based are in the facility file.
