Summary of Request: This is a request that the Program Director approve the issuance of a New Minor Waste Tire Facility Permit for B & J Auto Center, Inc. Alameda County, TPID No. 1586017. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

Staff received an application for a New Minor Waste Tire Facility Permit on October 15, 2009. The application was accepted as complete on November 17, 2009. CalRecycle is required to act by May 17, 2010.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends issuance of the permit. The applicant has met all the necessary application requirements outlined in 14 CCR, section 18431 pertaining to the issuance of a Minor Waste Tire Facility Permit. The required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. The documents and analysis, on which staff's findings are based, are in the facility file.
