Summary of Request: This is a request that the Branch Chief approve the issuance of a New Minor Waste Tire Facility Permit (WTFP) for Atlantis Tires, Inc., TPID No. 1103774, in the City of Gardena (Los Angeles County). Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

Staff received an application for a New Minor WTFP on May 20, 2013. The application was accepted on June 17, 2013. Based upon the acceptance of the application, CalRecycle is required to act by December 14, 2013.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit application package, staff recommends issuance of the Minor WTFP. The applicant has met all the necessary application requirements outlined in Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Section 18431 pertaining to the issuance of a New Minor WTFP. The documents and analysis on which staff's findings are based are permanently maintained by the Waste Permitting, Compliance, and Mitigation Division.

Branch Chief Action: On the basis of the information, analysis and findings in the staff report attached to this Request for Action and staff's recommendation, I hereby issue the New Minor Waste Tire Facility Permit for Atlantis Tires, Inc., TPID No. 1103774.
