Summary of Request: This is a request that the Branch Chief approve the issuance of a Renewal Major Waste Tire Facility Permit for Lakin Tire West Incorporated, TPID No. 1000659, in the City of Santa Fe Springs. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

Staff received an application for a Minor Waste Tire Facility Permit on October 7, 2011. The application was accepted on October 18, 2011, CalRecycle is required to act by April 15, 2012. The current permit expired on October 24, 2011.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit application package, staff recommends issuance of the permit. The applicant has met all the necessary application requirements outlined in Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Section 18431 pertaining to the issuance of a Major Waste Tire Facility Permit. The documents and analysis on which staff's findings are based are in the facility file.
