Summary of Request:

Staff requests approval of payments for the City/County Payment Program. The total funding available for Fiscal Year 2011/12 City/County Payment Program is \$10,500,000. Incorporated areas of a city, city and county, or the unincorporated area of a county (as reported by the California Department of Finance Annual City/County Population and Housing Estimate Report) are eligible to receive funding under this program. Jurisdictions receive funding on a per capita basis, or a minimum of \$5,000 for cities/\$10,000 for counties, whichever is greater.

Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) received 513 applications by the January 31, 2012 deadline as identified in Table 1. Twenty-five eligible entities did not submit applications. These funds, totaling \$257,602, were redistributed among the 513 submitted applicants based on population. The 25 cities and counties which did not apply are identified in Table 2.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends approval of City/County Payment Program awards as listed in Table 1 on page 2.



Background and Findings:

Statutory Authority

Pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 14581(a)(4)(A) of the California Beverage Container Recycling and Litter Reduction Act, CalRecycle is authorized to expend \$10,500,000 annually for payments to cities and counties for beverage container recycling and litter clean-up activities.

Program Background

The City/County Payment Program provides annual funding to California cities and counties for beverage container recycling projects that assist in achieving an 80% recycling rate for the State. Incorporated areas of a city, city and county, or the unincorporated area of a county (as reported by the California Department of Finance Annual City/County Population and Housing Estimate Report) are eligible to receive funding under this program. Jurisdictions receive funding on a per capita basis, or a minimum of \$5,000 for cities/\$10,000 for counties, whichever is greater.

Criteria and Process

On November 1, 2011, the City/County Payment Program Guidelines and the link to the Funding Request were emailed to the eligible 538 cities and counties. The deadline to submit the online applications was January 31, 2012.
