

2015 Annual Facility Methods Reporting


Due Dates:

(January 2015. –December 2015):

Due: April 15, 2016

2015 Annual Facility Methods reporting statistics

- 435 Annual Methods Reports were due
- 209 reports were received. 48% of the reports.
- 20 counties submitted all of their reports.
- 17 counties submitted some of their reports.
- 21 counties have not submitted any reports.



2015 Quarterly Station Notification Reporting

Quarterly Station Notification Due Dates to the Counties

- **1st Quarter (Jan. –Mar.): June 15, 2015**
- **2nd Quarter (Apr. –Jun.): Sept. 15, 2015**
- **3rd Quarter (Jul. –Sep.): Dec. 15, 2016**
- **4th Quarter (Oct. –Dec.): Mar. 15, 2016**

Quarterly Station Notification Reporting

- In January we announced a new optional form to simplify QSN reporting.
- The new optional form focuses on the key data we need to know.
- We will be sending out emails to all counties and facilities informing them of the new form with instructions.
- The new form is also located on our DRS website, under the FACILITY tab, by clicking on the “Facility Reporting Requirements” link.

Quarterly Station Notification Reporting

- 1184 Reports were due
- 703 reports were received.
- 59% of the reports were received.
- 13 counties submitted all of their reports.
- 35 counties submitted some of their reports.
- 8 counties are without permitted active stations.
- 2* counties have not submitted any reports.

2015 4th Quarter Disposal Reporting

Disposal Reporting Due Dates:

1st Quarter (Jan. –Mar.): July 15, 2015

2nd Quarter (Apr. –Jun.): Oct. 15, 2015

3rd Quarter (Jul. –Sep.): Jan. 15, 2016

4th Quarter (Oct. –Dec.): Apr. 15, 2016

Reporting Standards

- Reports must be submitted with regulatory required content.
- Reports should be submitted in the suggested format found on our DRS website.
- Reports should be submitted no later than the actual due dates.

AB 901 Updates

AB 901

- AB 901 was signed into law last year.
- AB 901 revises how we do Disposal Reporting and Recycling Activities.
- The first AB 901 workshop is scheduled here in Sacramento this afternoon April 19th at 1:00 pm. There will be another workshop in Southern California April 26th in Diamond Bar also at 1:00 pm.
- Counties will continue to report just as you did in 2015, until all systems are in place for reporting.
