
On October 1, 2010, the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) received your complete request for approval of the beneficial reuse of waste tires in the construction of safety barriers at Fast Lap Indoor Kart Racing, located in Mira Loma, Riverside County. Your request included information regarding the engineering and a cost benefit of the beneficial use of waste tires in safety barriers to reduce potential harm to race participants and the machinery without causing negative impacts to public health and safety or the environment. I determined that the use of waste tires as safety barriers at Fast Lap qualifies as a beneficial reuse as defined in Title 14, California Code of Regulations (14 CCR), Section 17346(f). As an approved beneficial use, the waste tires will not be determined to be stored or disposed and use does not require the issuance of a permit from CalRecycle.

Please note that if the beneficial use of waste tires is discontinued, Fast Lap Indoor Kart Racing or the legal operator and/or business owner is fully responsible for the removal and the proper recycling or disposal of the tires in a manner consistent with the waste tire laws and regulations.

CalRecycle staff or their authorized agents are authorized by regulation to inspect and/or carry out investigations at First Lap Indoor Kart Racing to determine continued compliance with requirements of 14 CCR Section 17346(f) for the beneficial use of the waste tires as well as other applicable waste tire laws and regulations.
