14. Prohibitions:

The permittee is prohibited from accepting any liquid sludge, non-hazardous waste requiring special handling, designated waste, or hazardous waste unless such waste is specifically listed below, and unless the acceptance of such waste is authorized by all applicable permits.

Scrap metal, appliances, tires, wood waste, green waste, recyclables, waste motor oil, oil filters, batteries, and household batteries, antifreeze, latex paint.

The permittee is additionally prohibited from the following items:

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17. LEA Conditions:

1. The design and operation of the facility must comply with all state, and local requirements and encumbrances.
2. The facility shall meet the design and operational requirements of Title 14, Chapter 3, Article 6.
3. The facility shall conform to the Wilfitts Solid Waste Transfer & Recycling Center 1997 Report of Station Information.
4. This permit is subject to review by the LEA and may be modified, suspended, or revoked for sufficient cause following a hearing.
5. The operator shall comply with the monitoring and reporting program established in Item 16 Self Monitoring of the solid Waste Facility Permit.
6. The operator shall not make any change that would cause the design or operation of the facility not to conform to the terms and conditions of this permit.
7. Baling, processing, loading, and unloading of recyclables and salvagables will not occur prior to 8 a.m.
8. Hazardous waste shall be stored in a secure, cool, well ventilated area. Storage of hazardous waste shall not exceed 90 days.
9. Removal frequency for refuse will be every 48 hours. Wood waste, green waste, and scrap metal shall be removed as needed.
10. Lighting shall be evaluated during winter operations. To insure safety additional lighting may be required by the LEA.
