- a. This permit is consistent with the County Solid Waste Management Plan or the County-wide Integrated Solid Waste Management Plan (CIWMP). Public Resources Code, Section 50000(a)1.
- b. This permit is consistent with standards adopted by the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB). Public Resources Code, Section 44010.
- c. The design and operation of the facility is in compliance with the State Minimum Standards for Solid Waste Handling and Disposal as determined by the LEA.
- d. The following local fire protection district has determined that the facility is in conformance with applicable fire standards as required in Public Resources Code, Section 44151: Maxwell Fire District.
- e. An environmental determination (i.e., Notice of Determination), negative declaration SCH#97042089, is filed with the State Clearinghouse for all facilities which are not exempt from CEQA and documents pursuant to Public Resources Code, Section 21081.6.
- f. A County-wide Integrated Waste Management Plan has not been approved by the CIWMB.
- g. The following authorized agent has made a determination that the facility is consistent with, and designated in, the applicable general plan: Charles Johnson, Colusa County Director of Planning and Building, Public Resources Code, Section 50000.5(a).
- h. The following local governing body has made a written finding that surrounding land use is compatible with the facility operation, as required in Public Resources Code, Section 50000.5(b). [Not applicable to a transfer station].

14. Prohibitions:

The permittee is prohibited from accepting any liquid waste sludge, non-hazardous waste requiring special handling, designated waste, or hazardous waste unless such waste is specifically listed below, and unless the acceptance of such waste is authorized by all applicable permits.

Notwithstanding the above, the following will be accepted for recycling: latex (water based) paint, car batteries, and waste motor oil.

The permittee is additionally prohibited from the following items:

Accepting hot ashes, liquid or oily waste (other than waste motor oil).

17. LEA Conditions:

- a. The operator is prohibited from making any changes in the design or operation of the facility which would cause the facility to be out of compliance with the terms and conditions of this Solid Waste Facilities Permit.
- b. The facility shall remain in compliance with all State Minimum Standards for solid waste handling and disposal.
- c. Storage and handling of hazardous wastes shall meet the most recent policies and regulations of the California Department of Toxic Substances Control, and shall not result in contamination of the environment, nor subject facility users or employees to any health or safety hazards.
- d. Salvaged or recyclable materials shall be stored so as not to create a nuisance. Salvaged materials shall be stored in bins. Salvaged materials shall be Removed within 180 days of receipt, or when storage bins are full, whichever occurs first.
- e. The operator shall maintain a Log of Special Occurrences on a form approved by the LEA. For each special occurrence, the operator shall indicate the outcome or corrective measures taken by the operator, if any.
- f. All litter and loose waste shall be picked up daily, and shall not be permitted to migrate off site.
- g. The generation of dust from the operation of the facility shall not create a nuisance or health hazard to facility users or site attendants.
- h. Waste shall be removed every 24 hours.
- i. Except for random load checks, all waste handling shall be conducted within the transfer building. Source separated recyclables shall be placed directly into storage bins.
- j. The new transfer building shall be completed and on-line by 1 January 1998.
