

Section 21685

The Board shall not concur in the issuance of a proposed permit if the following information, if applicable, has not been submitted to the CIWMB:

- The complete and correct RFI as certified by the LEA** - A certification from the LEA/EA that the permit package is complete and correct, including a statement that the RFI meets the requirements of PRC section 21600.
- Permit Review Report** - A permit review report which has been prepared pursuant to CCR section 21675, within the last five years.
- Conformance Finding Information** - If the CIWMP has not yet been approved, a statement that the facility complies with PRC section 50000 and PRC section 50000.5; or, if the CIWMP has been approved, a statement that the facility is in compliance with PRC section 50001.
- Complete Closure Plan** - For disposal sites, the Preliminary or Final Closure/Postclosure Maintenance Plan must be accompanied by a completeness determination.
- Financial Assurance Information** - For disposal sites, current documentation of acceptable funding levels for the approved Financial Assurance Mechanism.
- Operating Liability Information** - For disposal sites, current documentation of compliance with operating liability requirements.
- Land Use and/or Conditional Use Permits**
- Owner/Operator Certification** - All information in the application package shall be certified by the applicant and the owner of the site as being true and accurate to the best knowledge and belief of each. The applicant, owner of the facility, or both, shall supply additional information as deemed necessary by the LEA/EA.
- LEA/EA CEQA Finding** - A finding that the proposed permit is consistent with and is supported by existing CEQA analysis, or information regarding the progress toward CEQA compliance.
- Facility Compliance with State Minimum Standards**

Section 44009:**Reasons for Board to object to a permit**

- Section 44009(a)(2)** - If the board determines that the permit is not consistent with the state minimum standards adopted pursuant to Section 43020, or is not consistent with Section 43040, 43600, 44007, 44010, 44017, 44150, and 44152 or Division 31 (commencing w 50000), the board shall object to the provision of the permit and shall submit those objection to the LEA for its consideration.
- Section 43020** - The Board shall adopt regulations which set forth standards for solid waste handling, transfer, composting, transformation, and disposal.
 - Section 43040** - Financial Responsibility
 - Section 43600** - Financial Ability
 - Section 44007** - Provide Board and applicant copy of permit 65 days before issuance
 - Section 44010** - Permit shall be consistent with standards adopted by the Board
 - Section 44017** - No hazardous waste in waste-to-energy facilities
 - Section 44150** - Conditions for transformation facilities
 - Section 44152** - Transformation facilities must be consistent with state minimum standards
 - Section 50000** - Conformance with Integrated Waste Management Plan
