### NOTICE

**To: All Certified Processors**

**Subject: Scrap Value Reporting**

Public Resources Code (PRC) Section 14575 requires CalRecycle (Department) to determine the statewide average scrap values paid by certified processors to all sellers for all beverage container materials. Title 14, California Code of Regulations (CCR), Section 2425(f) specifies the reporting requirements for certified processors.

The monitoring of statewide average scrap values is necessary to calculate appropriate processing payments. Aluminum scrap values are not currently reported. A scrap value calculation is completed using prices from the American Metals Market publication. Statewide average Scrap Value Notices are published monthly and posted on the Department website.

As a certified processor, you are required to submit a Scrap Value Purchases Survey Form, DOR-SV (10/00) to the Department no later than the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the month following the actual reporting month. For example, total transactions for the month of January should be submitted no later than February 10<sup>th</sup>.

All purchases during any given month of glass, bimetal and all plastic resin beverage container material types, from all sellers, must be reported on the enclosed Scrap Value Purchases Survey Form.

If no purchases were made, the Scrap Value Purchases Survey Form must still be completed and submitted with zeros in all applicable areas or marked nothing to report.

Please take the time to review the itemized sample and step-by-step instructions enclosed for your assistance. The enclosed Scrap Value Purchase Survey Form may be copied for future submissions.
