The Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) will be hosting a public workshop on Alternative Methodology for Glass Cleaning for certified processors requesting to claim CRV on loads of glass with greater than 10 percent contamination.

This workshop will allow interested parties and participants to provide CalRecycle with industry's perspectives on current program requirements and discuss if current industry practices meet both the needs of industry and the goals of the beverage container program. CalRecycle will work with industry to explore potential revisions to the current regulations.

During this workshop, CalRecycle management and staff will present an overview of the current glass cleaning methodology requirements, and processor payment and reporting procedures. Management and staff will be on hand to answer questions and participants will be given an opportunity to share their ideas and express their concerns.
