Subject: Upcoming Public Workshop – Consumer Transaction Load Limits

The CalRecycle, Recycling Enforcement Branch (REB) will be hosting a public workshop regarding consumer transaction daily load limits on **October 26, 2011** in Sacramento. This is a follow on to the previous workshop on this topic held on August 4, 2011.

At the August 4, 2011 workshop, REB management provided an overview of the methodology and results of an analysis the REB/Risk Assessment & Data Management Section performed to derive average consumer transaction weights for comparison to the consumer transaction daily load limits currently in regulations. During the workshop, we answered questions and obtained feedback from attendees regarding the potential for revisions to the regulations based upon the results of the analysis.

At this workshop, REB management will present a variety of procedural and regulatory 'building blocks' designed not only to address the potential for fraud associated with the current consumer transaction daily load limits but to also ensure legitimate recycling opportunities are not compromised. The workshop discussion will be facilitated and all attendees will have the opportunity to provide feedback and input on the information presented.
