Good Morning,

As both of you are aware, I am the president of Better Building Products, DBA, The Carpet Recyclers, as well as its parent company, GF Industries, Inc. Although I could not be in attendance at yesterday's session, I was able to view the proceedings via Cal Recycles provided link. We thank Kathy for managing a diverse number of opinions in a civil manner and Bob for offering a very appropriate closing.

I would like to address the comments of Ms. Gail Brice that specifically mentioned The Carpet Recyclers or by way of reference pertained to The Carpet Recyclers. Ms Brice was not authorized to speak on behalf of The Carpet Recyclers nor was she authorized to disclose any information that may have been reported to either Cal Recycle or CARE under a "confidential" format. Ms. Brice's discussion of "estimated pounds of material to be produced in the second quarter of 2013" by the Carpet Recyclers, that was submitted in previous quarterly confidential submittals, was neither accurate nor relevant.

As a matter of clarification, Ms Brice was employed by The Carpet Recyclers until December 31, 2012. From January 1, 2013 she was employed by Nylon Recovery Corporation until all employees of that company were terminated on March 27, 2013. I am not in a position to confirm her employer at this time.

Recognizing that Ms Brice's comments covered a very broad spectrum of positions, I cannot reasonably request to strike all of her comments; however I do request that you do not consider any of her comments pertaining to The Carpet Recyclers as factual or credible.
