RE: NOTICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE CIVIL PENALTY ASSESSMENT

Dear Mr. Lapham:

The California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) has been given the legislative responsibility to implement the Recycled-Content Newsprint (RCN) Law (Public Resources Code [PRC] 42760-42791). This law requires all printers and publishers within the State of California to certify the amount of newsprint and/or RCN used within each calendar year. The certifications are due to the CIWMB by March 1 each year. If a certification is not received within 45 days of the due date, the printer or publisher is subject to a \$500 penalty pursuant to PRC section 42791, and Title 14, California Code of Regulations 14 CCR, section 17974(b).

Because we received your certification on April 22, 2004, after the 45-day penalty assessment date of April 15, 2004, the CIWMB is assessing an administrative civil penalty of \$500.

Pursuant to 14 CCR 17974 (d), you "... may appeal the penalty assessed to the full Board within ten (10) working days of the receipt of the Notice of Penalty. This appeal must be made in writing and must be addressed to me. I would then calendar the appeal for hearing by the Board within 30 days of the receipt of the written notification."
