**ISSUANCE OF A STIPULATED AGREEMENT  
TO TEMPORARILY MODIFY HOURS OF OPERATION OF STONYFORD  
LANDFILL (06-AA-0002)**

Colusa County Environmental Health, the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA), has received a written request for a stipulated agreement from the Colusa County Public Works Department (permit holder), the solid waste permit holder for the Stonyford Land Fill located in Stonyford, CA. Due to an active forest fire in the Mendocino National Forest located in western Colusa County, firefighters are temporarily housed at the Stonyford fairgrounds. There is an amount of municipal solid waste that is being generated by this temporary activity. The permit holder has requested that the hours of operation of the Stonyford Landfill be modified to accommodate the delivery of the municipal solid waste generated by the emergency activities. Current permitted hours of the landfill operation are Monday-Thursday 1000-1100 Hrs and 1500-1600 Hrs (Franchise Hauler) and Saturday 0900-1300 Hrs (Public).


After review of the request, the LEA has determined:

1. A temporary emergency exists. The Summit Forest Fire is burning in the Mendocino National Forest, located in the western portion of Colusa County. The firefighting staging area is at the Stonyford Fairgrounds in Stonyford, CA. Reportedly, approximately 350 firefighters are battling the fire and return to the staging area for rest and recuperation. Municipal solid waste is being generated by these activities.
2. The Colusa County Public Works Department holds a valid solid waste facilities permit for the Stonyford Landfill and is in substantial compliance of the permit and permit conditions.
3. It is necessary to waive specified terms and conditions of the permit in order to protect the public health and safety and the environment. Specifically, the hours of operation must be modified to accommodate the timely collection of additional municipal solid waste generated by the fire staging activities.
4. Operation under the stipulated agreement will not pose a threat to public health and safety or the environment.
5. Any restrictions, conditions, or terms contained in the stipulated agreement have been agreed upon by the LEA and the permit holder.

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. This stipulated agreement is solely to modify the hours of operation of the Stonyford Landfill to accommodate the municipal solid waste generated by the Summit Fire staging area.
2. The permit holder or operator shall record modified hours of operation and tonnage of MSW collected from the fire staging area operations. This information shall be available to the LEA upon request.
3. No hazardous materials or fire-related destruction debris will be collected and disposed of at the landfill.
4. The landfill shall not exceed maximum daily tonnage (10 tons per day) as specified in the permit conditions.
5. The commencement date of the modification of operating hours is August 13, 2009 and the modification will be in effect for no longer than ninety (90) days.
6. The permit holder will comply with 14CCR Section 17211.6 "Reporting Requirements for a Solid Waste Facility Operator", including a written report which shall include
  - a) Information regarding changes in operation that took place as a result of the stipulated agreement.
  - b) A request to discontinue the stipulated agreement on a date certain.

The undersigned, representing the permit holder and the local enforcement agency, have agreed to the requirements and conditions set forth in this stipulated agreement.
