Pursuant to the "Stipulation for Issuance of Administrative Decision" dated November 29, 2004 entered into by and between Complainant CALIFORNIA INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD (the "CIWMB"), and JUAN SALAZAR, Owner/Operator, of Salazar's Truck Tire Service ("Respondent") and good cause appearing therefore, the following Stipulated Factual Findings and Conclusions of Law are made, and the following Stipulated Order is issued:

STIPULATED FACTUAL FINDINGS

1. The CIWMB has authority to regulate and conduct enforcement actions regarding Waste Tire Haulers within the State of California under Public

Resources Code (PRC) section 42950 et seq. and attendant regulations contained in Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations (CCR).

2. RESPONDENT is responsible for the transportation of waste tires by a person not holding a waste tire hauler registration from the CIWMB.
3. An Administrative Complaint was issued by the CIWMB on September 15, 2004 to JUAN SALAZAR, Owner and Operator of SALAZAR'S TRUCK TIRE SERVICE seeking Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) in penalties.
4. RESPONDENT has communicated with CIWMB and agreed to said Stipulation for Issuance of Administrative Decision.

STIPULATED CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5. JUAN SALAZAR, Owner and Operator of SALAZAR'S TRUCK TIRE SERVICE is in violation of PRC section 42951, which makes it unlawful to contract or arrange with another person to transport waste or used tires not holding a valid waste and used tire hauler registration.
6. JUAN SALAZAR, Owner and Operator of SALAZAR'S TRUCK TIRE SERVICE acknowledges that he understands and agrees that he will not be provided with any hearing or other opportunity to contest the terms and conditions of the Stipulation for Issuance of Administrative Decision. In addition if RESPONDENT is deemed to be in default pursuant to the CIWMB determination, RESPONDENT understands he will not be provided a hearing to contest this determination.

**ADMINISTRATIVE DECISION BASED UPON STIPULATED FACTUAL FINDINGS
AND STIPULATED CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Pursuant to the Stipulated Factual Findings and Stipulated Conclusions of Law, and good cause appearing therefore, the following Administrative Decision is hereby issued in this proceeding:

- 1 (A) JUAN SALAZAR, Owner and Operator shall pay a monetary penalty of Five
2 Hundred Dollars, (\$500.00) to COMPLAINANT, the California Integrated
3 Waste Management Board.
4 (B) JUAN SALAZAR agrees to the COMPLAINANT recording a lien on any real
5 property owned by RESPONDENT for the amount of Five Hundred Dollars
