20 The California Integrated Waste Management Board ("CIWMB") served an  
21 Administrative Complaint and Request for Hearing form on Eric G. Canche d/b/a Taylor  
22 Fleet Truck Repair ("RESPONDENT"), on September 15, 2006. RESPONDENT  
23 negotiated a Stipulation for Issuance of Administrative Decision ("Stipulation") with the  
24 CIWMB to resolve the issues in the Administrative Complaint. Pursuant to the  
25 Stipulation entered into by and between the CIWMB and RESPONDENT and good  
26 cause appearing therefore, the following Stipulated Factual Findings and Procedural  
27 History of Default, and Supplemental Order is issued:

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1 RESPONDENT, where both parties agreed to settle the case in lieu of litigation.

2 8. On November 20, 2006, the CIWMB issued a Decision adopting said  
3 Stipulation of October 2, 2006. According to the Stipulation and Decision, \$1,125.00  
4 (one thousand one hundred twenty five dollars) was due on December 10, 2006. If  
5 RESPONDENT defaulted on any terms of the Stipulated Agreement, \$2,250.00 (two  
6 thousand two hundred fifty dollars) would become due and owing, and the  
7 RESPONDENT's Waste Tire Hauler registration would be revoked.

8 9. RESPONDENT failed to remit payment by the due date of December 10,  
9 2006.

10 10. On January 9, 2007, a letter was sent by fax and by U.S. Mail with proof of  
11 service, notifying RESPONDENT of the default and requesting payment by January 20,  
12 2007. The letter informed RESPONDENT that if no payment was received by the  
13 CIWMB by January 20, 2007, the CIWMB would find RESPONDENT in default. In  
14 addition, RESPONDENT was informed that according to the Stipulation, the Waste Tire  
15 Hauler registration would be revoked if RESPONDENT defaulted.

16 11. No payment was received by January 20, 2007.

17 12. RESPONDENT is in default of the October 2, 2006 Stipulation and the  
18 November 20, 2006 Decision.

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20 **SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER**

21 INSOMUCH AS ERIC G. CANCHE, d/b/a TAYLOR FLEET TRUCK  
22 REPAIR has failed to remit payment according to the terms of the Stipulation he has  
23 been deemed in default of said Stipulation and Decision, the stay is lifted and:

24 RESPONDENT'S Waste Tire Hauler Registration is revoked until  
25 December 31, 2007 effective 30 days from the date of this SUPPLEMENTAL  
26 DECISION and RESPONDENT shall return all decals to the CIWMB.

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This SUPPLEMENTAL DECISION shall become effective February 15, 2007.
