To squeeze as much value as possible from every dollar, they maintain cars, trucks and equipment themselves. Not much goes to waste in the Kings County farming community.

**Changing oil** and oil filters on the ranch or farm makes good sense. In addition to being more cost-effective, it's often a long drive to a service station for an oil change. Plus, they have the satisfaction of knowing the job is done right—the first time.

**How farmers dispose** of used oil and oil filters also effects the bottom line. Illegally dumping used oil can quickly wipe out the value of "Do It Yourself" oil changes by reducing the productivity of farm land and polluting groundwater supplies. In addition, illegally disposing of used oil can result in costly fines.

# Recycling Used Ag Oil


Handle used oil cautiously. Used motor oil can contain toxic substances such as benzene, lead, zinc and cadmium.

The careless disposal of ag and personal used oil can contaminate drinking water for our livestock, for our families—for everyone.

It makes dollars and public health sense to recycle used oil and oil filters. Used motor oil is the perfect recycling candidate, because it never wears out. Re-refining used motor oil is energy efficient, and re-refined oil prices are competitive with equivalent virgin oil products.

## Join the Kings County

ag community in properly disposing of used oil at one of the Certified Used Oil Collection Facilities listed in this brochure.



### Drain

Drain used oil from farm equipment and store waste oil in a standard steel 55 gallon drum. Ensure that the drum has both screw caps installed to prevent water intrusion and from oil leaking onto the ground at your site. Label each 55 gallon drum to ensure that waste oil does not get mixed with other drums.

### Transport

Transport a maximum of one 55 gallon drum of waste oil to one of the used oil recycling locations noted on this brochure. Call ahead to ensure the facility is open and accepting oil. Keep a copy of the variance for transport on the vehicle. Copies of the variance are available at each used oil recycling location.

### Recycle

Contact staff at the recycling location for assistance. Observe all posted safety precautions and verbal directions from facility personnel. At the recycling location, the waste oil will either be pumped from your 55 gallon drum or replaced with another drum. Do not attempt to pump the waste oil from the drum yourself.
