



## Protecting Dana Point Harbor

The ocean water is Dana Point Harbor's most valuable resource. As boaters, we enjoy what the ocean and Harbor provides through sport fishing, sight seeing or just a pleasure cruise. It is important that we take care of the water by following "Clean and Green Boating" tips!



Use bilge pads to soak-up oil and other petroleum products. Do not release oily bilge water into the Harbor!



Drop-off used oil and used bilge pads at the Fuel Dock or the Marinas at Dana Point Harbor (refer to map for locations).



Recycle oil filters, batteries, antifreeze and transmission fluid. Most marinas, fuel docks and services centers accept these items for recycling or proper disposal.



Dana Point Harbor is a "no discharge" zone and boaters will be fined for violations.

*By knowing the law and following a few simple rules, Dana Point Harbor and our oceans will be safe, clean and enjoyable for generations to come.*

The County of Orange, in conjunction with the Marinas and Fuel Dock, operates a free Bilge Pad Exchange Program to preserve and enhance the quality of the marine environment at Dana Point Harbor. This exchange program provides conveniently located collection points for used bilge pads and distributes *free* replacement bilge pads.



*Dana Point Harbor boaters and mechanics can easily -- and harmlessly -- dispose of their used bilge pads and obtain free bilge pads for future use.*



*The program is for anybody at Dana Point Harbor who uses or disposes bilge pads.*

**Uses for bilge pads include:**

- Keeping a bilge clean during and after an oil change.
- Continuous absorption of oil or other petroleum products that may leak into the bilge.
- Cleaning up and containing small, accidental spills of oil, hydraulic fluid, diesel fuel and other petroleum products in harbor waters.

There are three locations around Dana Point Harbor to properly dispose of your used bilge pads and/or receive free, new pads:


**Dana Point Harbor Fuel Dock**

- Drop-off used bilge pads to Fuel Dock personnel for disposal.
- New bilge pads will be provided free of charge.

**Dana West Marina and Dana Point Marina Company**

- Request key to yellow disposal/storage containers from Marina personnel.
- Drop-off used pads in proper container.
- Pick-up new pads...take only what you need.
- Return key to Marina personnel.

Please put used bilge pads in a plastic bag or other "leak-proof" container to transport.
