

NOTICE TO HD20 APPLICANTS

Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) typically requires Grantees to return executed Grant Agreements within 90 days of the date the Grant Agreement is emailed.

However, due to unusual circumstances beyond our control, if you are awarded a Household Hazardous Waste Grant for FY 2012/13 (HD20), you **WILL NOT** have the full 90 days to return the executed Grant Agreement that you typically have. CalRecycle anticipates that you will have approximately 45 – 55 days to obtain the signature of your Signature Authority on the Grant Agreement and return it to CalRecycle.

CALRECYCLE MUST RECEIVE YOUR EXECUTED GRANT AGREEMENT NO LATER THAN **JUNE 24, 2013, OR CALRECYCLE WILL BE STATUTORILY PROHIBITED FROM FUNDING THE GRANT.**

If your jurisdiction requires that you obtain specific authorization from your Board or Council to accept a grant, please place an item on your Board or Council's agenda in anticipation of being awarded an HD20 Grant with sufficient time to allow you to meet this June 24, 2013, deadline. While there is no guarantee that you will be awarded an HD20 Grant, CalRecycle recommends that you make any arrangements necessary for you to meet the June 24, 2013, deadline, in advance, so that you will be fully prepared if you are awarded an HD20 Grant.
