



Plan for Supporting the Safe Collection and Proper Disposal of Sharps Waste

Salix Pharmaceuticals, Inc. (referred to herein as “Salix”) currently has one product that may be administered at home by self-injection: RELISTOR[®] (methyl naltrexone bromide) subcutaneous injection. Following is the plan that Salix has outlined in the product’s Medication Guide for the proper collection and disposal of Sharps waste supplies:

- Used pre-filled syringes are to be placed in a closable, puncture-resistant container. A Sharps container (such as a red biohazard container), a hard plastic container (such as a detergent bottle), or metal container (such as an empty coffee can) can be used for this purpose.
- There may be state and local laws about how used needles and syringes should be thrown away, therefore patients are advised to ask their healthcare provider for instructions on the right way to dispose of the container.

As mentioned above, this information is provided in the product’s Medication Guide, which is included in the Prescribing Information (PI) as well as on Salix’s website.
