




AB 939 - Integrated Waste Management Hierarchy and LEA Authority



Solid Waste Laws and Regulations

State of California-

- **Integrated Waste Management Act of 1989 (AB 939)**
 - Diversion Mandates: 50% by 2000
 - CIWMB, LEAs, Permits & Enforcement
- **Public Resources Code (PRC)**
 - Codified sections of AB 939
 - Authorizes CIWMB and LEAs Authorities

Solid Waste Laws and Regulations

- **California Code of Regulations**

- Title 27: *Landfill Disposal Standards, Active & Closed Sites, Full Permit Processing.*
- Title 14: *Solid Waste Handling, Transfer, Composting, Soil Treatment, Tires, Tiered Permits, LEA Certification Requirements.*

LEA Certification Requirements



- **Technical Expertise** (14 CCR 18072)
 - At least one REHS on staff.
- **Adequacy of Staff Resources** (14 CCR 18073)
- **Adequacy of Budget Resources** (14 CCR 18074)
- **Training Requirements** (14 CCR 18075)
