EXISTING LAWS & REGS

PRC Section 44004...

- Requires EA to notice and hold hearing on revised permit
- Requires CIWMB to adopt regulations to implement new hearing requirement

CDI Regulations...

- Requires EA to notice and hold hearing on new permit allows comparable hearing

Title 27 Section 21565 ...

- Requires EA to hold hearing on exemption from permit

NOTE: Both AB 1497 and CDI regulations require notice of a public hearing to be pursuant to Government Code Section 65091
