A. RWQCB (STAFF):

PROPOSED GREGORY CANYON LANDFILL - (Carol) On March 1, 2005, the RWQCB issued a letter of determination that the JTD was complete. We plan to conduct at least one public workshop before placing this item on the agenda for consideration by the Regional Board. PILOT TEST STEAM INJECTION AT WEST MIRAMAR LF- (Carol) On February 2, 2005, the RWQCB issued a conditional concurrence letter to the City of San Diego regarding a proposal to conduct a Pilot Test for steam injection at the West Miramar Landfill (see letter attached to email).

WDR RELATED ITEMS:

CAMPBELL SHIPYARD UNDERWATER CAPPING PROJECT (Brian) On October 13, 2004, the RWQCB adopted Order R9-2004-0295: Waste Discharge Requirements for the Port of San Diego Campbell Shipyard Bay Sediment Cap Closure And Post Closure Maintenance, San Diego Bay." The WDRs prescribe construction, maintenance and monitoring requirements for an underwater cap over 11 acres located in the offshore area of the former Campbell Shipyard leasehold. PRIMA DESHECHA LANDFILL (Orange County) (Amy) The RWQCB has received a JTD for construction of additional lined areas in compliance with WDRs issued as Order R9-2003-0306. We are reviewing the JTD at this time.

RWQCB ENFORCEMENT ITEMS:

LAS PULGAS LANDFILL, MCB CAMP PENDLETON - (Amy/Rich) The RWQCB has reviewed technical reports regarding the construction and performance of the of the waste management unit known as Phase 1 expansion area at Las Pulgas Landfill. The unit has experienced a number of problems: extensive slope slumping, ineffective leachate seeps, and damage to the liner system. During the period from Jan 1 to Feb 11, the RWQCB issued 2 NOVs and 1 investigative Order to the USMC for conditions at Las Pulgas Landfill. We are completing work on a draft Cleanup and Abatement Order against the USMC for failures comply with the construction and reporting requirements of existing WDRs in Order No. 2000-054.

BRADLEY PARK/OLD LINDA VISTA LANDFILL, SAN MARCOS - (Amy) The RWQCB issued an NOV R9-2005-0034 for failure to contain the wastes discharged into the unit. On January 26th the staff observed a discharge of polluted groundwater, from the northern sideslope at the unit, into the storm drain system (MS4). We are completing work on a draft Cleanup and Abatement Order against the City of San Marcos to cleanup and abate groundwater pollution and implement corrective actions to remedy the observed discharge into the MS4.

VALLEY CENTER LANDFILL – (Amy) The County DPW has worked out an access agreement with the property owner located adjacent to the landfill. The DPW has been drilling a monitoring well downgradient of the landfill and previously identified seeps. On January 21, 2005, the RWQCB issued addendum no. 1 to the cleanup order No. R9-2004-039 for Valley Center Landfill. The addendum extends the due date for the feasibility study and amended Report of Waste Discharge for 60 days (until April 2, 2005).

Ongoing enforcement actions for San Marcos LF (CDO), Jamacha LF (CAO), and Ramona LF (CAO). No additional enforcement actions to report at this time.
