CalRecycle is available to join EAC and/or the subcommittee in further deliberations on the five main issues identified in the guidance for further discussions:

- Role of the sub-committee (members have been identified as Bill Prinz, Dennis Ferrier and Brian Pitts);
- Criteria for deciding whether a full or expedited review is necessary;
- Time frames for review;
- Refinement of the review process and discussion of acceptable contingencies;
- Develop a process for rescission of guidance documents and LEA Advisories.

We look forward to working with EAC to iron out remaining details to assure that draft guidance documents are afforded the most comprehensive review before release as final guidance within any given circumstance.
