

**ENFORCEMENT ADVISORY COUNCIL
RESOLUTION 2012-02**

**HONORING DENNIS FERRIER
FOR HIS SERVICE IN THE FIELD OF SOLID WASTE**

WHEREAS, Dennis Ferrier was one of the first members of Enforcement Advisory Council (EAC) and the Solid Waste Policy Committee (SWPC), and which included Koeppe, Calvert, Hanson, Manasjian, Samaniego, Pirie, Grossberg, Prinz, Blood, Genter, Hunter, Pacheco, Krug, Henshaw, Holm, Schmaeling, and many more; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Ferrier was always intent on environmental health and safety, protecting the integrity and high regard of the REHS, and clear interpretation of the regulations; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Ferrier was a living archive and had a photographic memory of all resolutions, regulations, statutes, letters, LEA advisories, etc., whether it was a document from 1993 or 2000 or any other year, and he would call you on any perceived errors or omissions; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Ferrier could probably remember the exact date and which California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) members were present when CIWMB Resolution 83-1 was passed forming the EAC; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Ferrier, was a lead contributor to Advisory #31 – Advisory Enforceability, which stated that “All future advisories will include a statement to reflect their non-enforceability, that the advisories do not take precedence over statute or regulation”—which addressed the great issue of underground regulation; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Ferrier was identified in the 1996 EAC meeting notes: DF comment – *Fire Alarm*” (*interrupted by...*), which must have been at the time of a hot topic and a powerfully good answer coming from Dennis such that CIWMB did not want to hear it; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Ferrier was integral in the continued effort of electronic data submittal; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Ferrier most likely has the Permit Desk Manual in hard copy, microfiche, CD, and thumb drive; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Ferrier was a significant contributor on the 1996 and 2000 team of CCDEH and CWIMB that resulted in the development of the LEA/CIWMB (CalRecycle) conference; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Ferrier worked with Chair Don Koepp on successfully fighting the 1993 attempt to eliminate the EAC and Permit Streamlining (single regulations for each solid waste facility type, keep the LEA as a lead agency); and

WHEREAS, if Dennis Ferrier prefaced his comments with the word “historically” you knew he would not stop talking for at least 45 minutes; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Ferrier was passionate about his work and wasn’t afraid to stir the pot or rattle CIWMB staff over controversial issues; and


WHEREAS, Dennis Ferrier was a strong proponent for local autonomy for LEAs; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Ferrier was an exemplary Orator, Pontificator, and eloquent statesman for the City perspectives; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Ferrier always had an opinion that he needed to let you hear, it was never unappreciated; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Ferrier, LEA legend, as evident by this collection of accolades and quips from his former colleagues, will be greatly missed by all.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Enforcement Advisory Council (EAC) on June 26, 2012, by unanimous vote, adopted a resolution honoring Dennis Ferrier and his many years of honorable and dedicated service in the field of solid waste, and which was of great benefit to the people of California.
