
On February 26, 2014, the Enforcement Advisory Council (EAC) voted to approve the establishment of a multi-agency working group under its direction and oversight to delineate Enforcement Agency challenges to properly identify, mitigate, remediate, or enforce state minimum standards at closed, illegal, and abandoned disposal sites for the long-term protection of public health.

The structure and objectives of the working group are attached, along with a preliminary scope of key issue areas identified by Local Enforcement Agencies (LEAs) from the various regions across the State. Overarching priority consideration will be given to post-closure land use development concerns and identified barriers to effectively remediating illegal or abandoned disposal sites.

The EAC respectfully requests active participation and input by CalRecycle staff, as available; since your continued participation in this discussion is seen by the EAC as critical to the overall effectiveness of the working group. An initial scoping and organization meeting will be conducted on May 6, 2014 at 3:00 PM at the Cal-EPA Office in Sacramento.
