I am writing in response to Enforcement Advisory Council (EAC) Resolution 2014-03 received April 30, 2014, which was passed at the February 26, 2014 EAC meeting.

The resolution approved the establishment of a multi-agency working group to delineate Enforcement Agency challenges to properly identify, mitigate, remediate, or enforce state minimum standards at closed, illegal, and abandoned disposal sites for the long-term protection of public health.
