Introductory paragraph

As a property owner, tenant, or person who has requested notice, please be advised that the City of Any Town Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and is considering an application to modify the solid waste facility permit (SWFP) for the Mighty Fine Landfill. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the City of Any Town, including all active and closed landfills.

Description of project, EA's preliminary determination and date EA accepted permit

Description of Project and LEA's Preliminary Determination

Mighty Fine Landfill is an approximately 450-acre existing landfill site located at 1234 Hollywood Boulevard in the East Community Plan area approximately one mile north of Highway 25 and approximately a mile west of the City of Revenue. On June 6, 2006, the LEA accepted for review the permit application package to the SWFP from Mighty Fine Landfill, Inc. requesting a change to update the waste discharge requirement issued in 1998 currently referenced in the permit to WDR issued in May 2006. No other change to the SWFP is under consideration at this time.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is a non-material change pursuant to Title 27 §21665 and qualifies as a permit modification. The LEA's preliminary determination is that the proposed permit modification be approved.

The decision to issue or not to issue the SWFP (revision, modified, new) must be made by the LEA within 120 days of the date the application was deemed complete as required by Statute. Prior to issuance of the SWFP, the LEA must request and receive concurrence from the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB).
