

NO. 93-73RESOLUTION SPECIFYING FUNDING SOURCES FOR VARIOUS  
CAPITAL AND OPERATING EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH THE  
PROPOSED COUNTY-OPERATED YARD WASTE COLLECTION  
FACILITY AT RED HILL

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has directed Public Works to proceed with the development of a County-operated yard waste collection facility at the Red Hill Landfill site; and,

WHEREAS, various capital and operating expenses are required for the construction and operation of the proposed facility;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors, County of Calaveras, State of California, that funding for the various expenses shall be as follow:

1. Costs for the required loader bucket attachment in an amount of \$16,601.12 shall be funded from Department 95's FY 1992/93 recycling budget as shown on the attached budget transfer form. The Auditor/Controller is hereby directed to amend the books of record for fixed assets to include this item.
2. Costs for site construction, including necessary utility services, support structures, and related site improvements, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 shall be funded from the Solid Waste Capital Improvement Trust Fund as shown on the attached budget transfer form.
3. Costs for the hauling collected yard waste material from the Red Hill Collection Site to Hyponex for composting shall be based on a unit cost of \$25.50 per ton and shall be funded from Department 95's FY 1992/93 recycling budget.




