Subject: Comments on Informal Draft Regulatory Text for Used Mattress Recycling Program

Dear Ms. Dunn,

On behalf of the City of Los Angeles Bureau of Sanitation, the following are our comments on the draft regulatory text for the used mattress recycling program. We recommend that the text be revised to read as follows:

Section 18967 Solid Waste Annual Report

(b) (2)

Quantitative information on the number of used mattresses received by that facility that were recycled, renovated, or disposed of within the state in the preceding calendar year **only if the operation of the Solid Waste Facility is not hampered in any way and the operating permit of such a facility allows for and requires the collection of such information. Where collection of such information poses any risk of danger to individuals working in the Solid Waste Facility, the Facility may elect to use source analysis to estimate the quantities of used mattresses received based on information provided to them by customers of that facility.** Conversion factor(s), if used, shall also be provided.
