Here are my thoughts. Section 42987.1(n) used the term consumers for the free dropoff which makes it consistent with the plan. (o) can also be interpreted to meet one mattress versus multiple mattresses. MRC can likely interpret this (o) provision of a mattress to be the mattress top and box springs in line with the (n) provision that allows multiple mattresses. On the contract side, it does allow for multiple and likely unlimited amounts which could lead to fraud. Maybe a limit of five or six mattresses could be brought in at any one time.
