

## Tier Placement for Transfer/Processing Operations and Facilities

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•<b>Auto Dismantler</b> – Dismantles vehicles for the sale of used vehicle parts.</li> <li>•<b>Auto Shredder Operations</b> – Renders automobiles or white goods into small pieces and separates the materials for recycling.</li> <li>•<b>Buy Back Centers</b></li> <li>•<b>Drop-off Centers Section</b></li> <li>•<b>Manufacturers</b> – Uses new or separated for reuse materials as a raw material in making a finished product distinct from those raw materials.</li> <li>•<b>Recycling Centers</b> – Receives only material that has been separated for reuse prior to receipt and has less than 10% residual waste.</li> <li>•<b>Rendering Plants</b> – Processes dead animals or parts for the purpose of obtaining the hide, skin, grease residue or other byproducts.</li> <li>•<b>Reuse Salvage Operations</b> – Processes nonputrescible separated for reuse materials and recovers distinct material types for recycling or reuse. Furniture and mattress dismantlers are examples.</li> <li>•<b>Scrap Metal Recyclers and Dealers</b> – Receives and processes secondhand or castoff metal material.</li> <li>•<b>Wire Choppers</b> – Uses source separated metal components or wire for recycling or reuse.</li> <li>•<b>Wood, Paper, or Wood Product Manufacturer</b> – Uses separated for reuse paper or woody materials in order to produce a finished product or in the manufacture of another product without further processing.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•<b>Locations</b> where &lt;15 cubic yards of combined container volume is provided to serve as multi-residence receptacles for residential refuse at the place of generation. Section 17403.1(a)(1)</li> <li>•<b>Locations</b> where &lt;15 cubic yards of combined container volume is handled for recycling. Section 17403.1(a)(2)</li> <li>•<b>Storage</b> receptacle at the place of generation for waste from multi-residential buildings or for commercial solid wastes. Section 17403.1(a)(3)</li> <li>•<b>Containers</b> used to store construction or demolition wastes at the place of generation. Section 17403(a)(4)</li> <li>•<b>Containers</b> used to store salvaged materials. Section 17403.1(a)(5)</li> <li>•<b>Waste Hauling Yard Operations.</b> Section 17403.1(a)(6)</li> <li>•<b>Storage</b> of other discrete wastes streams... Section 17403(1)(a)(7)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•<b>Emergency Transfer/ Processing Operations</b> – an operation that handles only disaster or similar debris, established in a state of emergency.</li> <li>•<b>Sealed Container Transfer Operations</b> – handles only waste previously placed in tightly closed containers with impermeable covers. Less than 96 hour storage.</li> <li>•<b>Limited Volume Transfer Operations</b> – a transfer operation that receives less than 60 cubic yards or 15 tons of waste per day. No processing of waste.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•<b>Medium Volume Transfer/ Processing Facility</b>- a transfer and/or processing facility that receives at least 60 cubic yards or 15 tons but less than 100 tons per day.</li> <li>•<b>Direct Transfer Facility</b> - a transfer facility that receives at least 60 cubic yards or 15 tons but less than 150 tons per day. The waste must be transferred only once from one covered container to another so the waste is never outside the confines of a container. Less than 8 hour storage.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•<b>Large Volume Transfer/ Processing Facility</b> - a transfer and/or processing facility that receives 100 tons or more waste per day.</li> </ul> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;">Notes:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Full permit processing requirements are located in 27 CCR Sections 21570 – 21650</li> <li>2. Tiered permit processing requirements are located in 14 CCR Sections 18100 – 18105</li> <li>3. The transfer operation and facility tiers are located 14 CCR Sections 17400 – 17403</li> <li>4. There are no transfer facilities placed within the Standardized tier.</li> </ol>
