An application for a Compostable Materials Handling Facility Permit (Solid Waste Facility Permit - SWFP) for the Redwood Landfill Compost Facility was deemed complete and correct on September 13, 2013. This meeting is for all interested parties to provide comments on the proposed SWFP. Interested parties can ask questions and provide comments. Comments may be submitted prior to the meeting, directly to Mr. Janofsky at the above address and email, or by fax. No decisions will be made at this meeting.

Proposed Compost Facility operations include:

- A permit will be issued for the compost facility separate from the landfill operations;
- Allowable compostable materials are: green material (including wood waste), food material, biosolids, agricultural material.
- An increase in tonnage of material to be composted from 170 to 514 tons per day.
- Covered Aerated Static Pile method will be used to compost the material.
- The total vehicle count for both the landfill and the compost facility will increase from 662 to 690 vehicles per day.

Any appeal will be processed in accordance and pursuant to Public Resource Code sections 44307 and 44310 (PRC §44307). Appeals can only be made after the decision to issue or deny the permit has occurred.
