### Introduction

The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health Solid Waste Management Program (SWMP), acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA), is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within its jurisdiction. The Compton Recycling and Transfer Station operates under a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) issued by the SWMP and has filed a Report of Facility Information (RFI), which describes the design and operation of the facility, with the SWMP.

### Description of Project

On October 6, 2006, the Governing Board of the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) adopted Rule 410 – Odors from Transfer Stations and Material Recovery Facilities. Rule 410 requires owners or operators of facilities subject to the rule to submit either a SCAQMD – approved Rule 410 Odor Management Plan or a LEA – approved Alternative Odor Management Plan (AOMP) by January 1, 2008. The operator of Compton Recycling and Transfer Station has proposed changes to the RFI in order to comply with Rule 410.

**LEA's Determination**

The operator submitted an application for RFI amendments to the SWMP on June 18, 2007. The SWMP reviewed the application and determined that the proposed changes are exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act documents, are consistent with State Minimum Standards, and do not conflict with the terms and conditions of the current SWFP, pursuant to Section 21665(c) of Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations (27 CCR). The SWMP approved the RFI amendments on July 18, 2007.

As required by Section 21660.1 of 27 CCR, the SWMP is distributing this notice for the purpose of noticing its acceptance of the amendments to the RFI for the Compton Recycling and Transfer Station.
