LEA Findings per §21665(c): The LEA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with all CEQA documents; is acceptable and consistent with all state minimum standards; and the proposed changes do not conflict with the existing solid waste facility permit (SWFP).

Description of Proposed Changes: Waste Management of Orange Transfer Station proposes to add equipment to process recyclable organic materials. Collected organic materials will be placed into a pulper to reduce the particle size and volume, and reduce water content. If necessary, the resulting material may then be fed into a dehydrator to remove the remaining moisture. The pulping and dehydrating processes result in a nutrient-rich product that is to be sent offsite to various third party users. All recyclable processing activities will occur within the transfer station buildings at the facility.
