Introduction

Please be advised that the County of Sacramento Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for L and D Landfill. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recovery and Recycling to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within the County and City of Sacramento.

Description of project and LEA's determination

L and D Landfill is a 251 acre site in the City of Sacramento and is operated by L and D Landfill, LP and owned by Fruitridge Road Land Company. L and D Landfill is designed to assist the County of Sacramento and other jurisdictions in complying with local waste reduction and recycling goals and ordinances. L and D Landfill accepts residential and commercial refuse. This facility is located at 8635 Fruitridge Road, Sacramento, CA 95826. On December 23, 2010, the LEA received from L and D Landfill, a SWFP application package to amend the RFI requesting to revise the document to:

- Use processed green waste and geosynthetic fabric as alternative daily cover.
- Update the RFI pursuant to the changes requested in the 5 Year Permit Review Report dated September 3, 2010.

No other change to the SWFP is under consideration at this time. The LEA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with the California Department of Resources, Recovery and Recycling State Minimum Standards, and is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents. The proposed changes do not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit. The LEA approved the amendment on December 30, 2010.
