The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health, Solid Waste Management Program (SWMP), acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) is certified by the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within its jurisdiction. City Terrace operates under a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) issued by the SWMP. The operator has filed an application of a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment with the SWMP. The RFI describes the design and operation of the facility.

As required by 27 CCR, Section 21660.1, the SWMP is distributing this notice for the purpose of noticing its acceptance of the amendments to the RFI for City of Terrace Recycling and Waste Transfer Station.

Description of Project

The facility added a sorting line system and relocated the already existent bailer next to the sorting line. Within the first three months of operating the new sorting line, there was an increase in the facility diversion rate from 6.65% to 9.05%. This translates into approximately 10,000 tons of material diverted from landfills.

LEA's Determination

An application for RFI amendments was received by the SWMP on February 22, 2011. Pursuant to Title 27, California Code of Regulations (27 CCR), Section 21665 (c), the SWMP reviewed the application and determined that the proposed change is consistent with all adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards and do not conflict with the terms and conditions of the current SWFP. The SWMP approved the RFI amendments on March 02, 2011.
