### **Background**

On February 28, 2011 Glenn County Environmental Health, the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for solid waste facilities within the county, received an application requesting an amendment to the facility's *Report of Facility Information (RFI)*. The LEA found the application incomplete and requested that the operator submit an amended application. The LEA received an amended application from the operator on March 11, 2011.

The application requested changes to the RFI, also known at this site as the *Report of Disposal Site Information (RDSI)*, an operating document the facility must adhere to in order to comply with state regulations. Changes requested include a request to reduce the facility's operating hours and to update personnel requirements described in the RDSI to match the reduced operating hours.

### **LEA Determination & Approval**

The LEA has determined that the changes requested are consistent with the requirements for an RFI amendment pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 27, Section 21665(c), meeting all of the following:

- The requested amendments are consistent with the current Solid Waste Facility Permit and do not require a permit revision or modification.
- The requested amendments are consistent with State Minimum Standards for solid waste disposal facilities.
- The requested amendments are consistent with previously adopted CEQA documents and no supplemental EIR or negative declaration is required.

The LEA approved the requested RFI amendments on March 16, 2011. The facility may implement the requested changes immediately.
