The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health, Solid Waste Management Program (SWMP), acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) is certified by the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within its jurisdiction. Construction and Demolition Recycling operates under a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) issued by the SWMP. On **January 30, 2013**, the operator filed an application for amendments to their Report of Facility Information (RFI).

Description of Project

The RFI amendments consist of the following:

- Acceptance and processing of green material.
- Addition of a grinder for green material processing.
- The facility is operating under Phase II of their CUP which allows them to accept up to 1,500 tons per day of material.

LEA's Determination

Pursuant to Title 27, California Code of Regulations (27 CCR), Section 21665 (c), SWMP reviewed the application and determined that the proposed amendments are consistent with all adopted CEQA documents, consistent with State Minimum Standards and do not conflict with the terms and conditions of the current SWFP. The SWMP approved the RFI amendments on **February 8, 2013**.
