Proposed Amendment to the Report of Facility Information for:

Imperial Solid Waste Site (SWIS # 13-AA-0001) **(Class III Solid Waste Disposal Facility)**

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, in compliance with Section 21660.1, Title 27, of the California Code of Regulations, that the Imperial County Division of Environmental Health, Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for the California Department of Resources, Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), has approved an application to amend the Report of Facility Information (RFI) for the Imperial Solid Waste Site as described below:

Date of Application: April 1, 2013

Description of Changes:

- Revise the description of bulky waste handling and e-waste and tire acceptance at the site;
- Extend the operating hours during the current operating days for site maintenance;
- Incorporate the existing gas monitoring control network that was installed in 2009;
- Include the constructed location of groundwater monitoring wells I-DW-5 and I-WW-2R;
- Incorporate an access road that was constructed on the west perimeter of the site;
- Revise the preliminary grading and drainage plan for closure of the site in March 2019;
- Include new site life capacity and closure date estimates based on a 2011 aerial survey; and
- Update the Emergency Response Plan.

Date of LEA Approval: On April 25, 2013, the LEA approved the RFI Amendment Application for the Imperial Solid Waste Site. The LEA has determined that the proposed revisions are consistent with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Solid Waste Facility Permit, and Title 27, CCR (State Minimum Standards). A copy of the amendments are on file and available for public review in the LEA office located at 797 W. Main Street, Suite B, in El Centro.
