

NOTICE TO FY 2012/13 APPLICANTS

The Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) typically requires proposed Grantees to return executed Grant Agreements within 90 days of the date the Grant Agreement is emailed as well as pay any outstanding debt 90 days from the date of the award Request for Approval.

However, due to unusual circumstances beyond our control, if you are awarded a grant from any of the following grant programs, you **WILL NOT** have the full 90 days to return the executed Grant Agreement or pay any outstanding debt that you typically have.

CALRECYCLE MUST RECEIVE YOUR EXECUTED GRANT AGREEMENT AND PAYMENT OF ANY OUTSTANDING DEBT NO LATER THAN THE INDICATED DATE, OR CALRECYCLE WILL BE STATUTORILY PROHIBITED FROM FUNDING THE GRANT.

Tire-Derived Product Grant Program – Grant Agreement and outstanding debt due by **June 17, 2013**

If your jurisdiction requires that you obtain specific authorization from your Board or Council to accept a grant, please place an item on your Board or Council's agenda in anticipation of being awarded a grant with sufficient time to allow you to meet the specified deadline. While there is no guarantee that you will be awarded any grants for which you may have applied, CalRecycle recommends that you make any arrangements necessary for you to meet the specified deadline(s), in advance, so that you will be fully prepared if you are awarded one or more of the above-referenced grants.
