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Please be advised that the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), acting as the Solid Waste Enforcement Agency (EA) for Santa Cruz County, has received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment per Title 27, California Code of Regulations (27 CCR), Section 21665(c). This public notice was prepared pursuant to Title 27 CCR 21660.1.

**Project Description**

The Ben Lomond Transfer Station is an existing solid waste transfer/processing facility operating under a full Solid Waste Facilities Permit issued on September 15, 2000. The application package to amend the RFI requests the following changes: update to site personnel; update to recycling activities for batteries, mattresses, plastics, carpet and C&D; relocation of C&D recycling area to outside of the permitted boundary; inclusion of a misting system; and updates to maps and site information reflecting the above changes.

The EA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit.
