Parcel 1: All that portion of real property situated in Section 3, Township 30 North, Range 6 West, M.D.B. & M., in the unincorporated area of County of Shasta, State of California; being APNs 045-020-001 & 045-020-002.

Parcel 2: All that portion of real property situated in Section 2, Township 30 North, Range 6 West, M.D.B. & M., in the unincorporated area of County of Shasta, State of California, lying southerly of Clear Creek Road (County Road 1C01B) and lying westerly of Cloverdale Road (County Road 2G05). Excepting therefrom all that portion of real property conveyed to David Lee Saul and Anna M. Saul, husband and wife as joint tenants, recorded August 13, 2012 in Official Records Document 2012-0026646, Shasta County Records; being APNs 205-420-003 & 205-420-010.

Parcel 3: All that portion of real property situated in the South one-half of Section 35, Township 31 North, Range 6 West, M.D.B. & M., in the unincorporated area of County of Shasta, State of California, lying southerly of Clear Creek Road (County Road 1C01B) and lying westerly of Cloverdale Road (County Road 2G05). Excepting therefrom all that portion of real property conveyed to the Clear Creek Community Services District, by Grant Deed recorded June 23, 1995 in Book 3303 of Official Records at Page 154, Shasta County Records; being APNs 041-350-024 & 041-350-059.

Parcel 4: All that portion of real property situated in the South one-half of Section 34, Township 31 North Range 6 West, M.D.B. & M., in the unincorporated of County of Shasta, State of California, lying southerly of Clear Creek Road (County Road 1C01B); being APNs 041-660-005, 041-660-006, 041-660-014, & 041-660-015.

Parcel 5: All that portion of real property being lots 1 and 2 situated in the Northeast one-quarter of Section 4, Township 30 North, Range 6 West, M.D.B. & M., in the unincorporated area of County of Shasta, State of California, being APNs 045-202-010 & 045-020-011.

Parcel 6: All that portion of real property situated in the Southeast one-quarter of Section 4, Township 30 North, Range 6 West, M.D.B. & M., in the unincorporated area of County of Shasta, State of California, as described below:

The easterly 300 feet of said Southeast one-quarter and the southerly 100 feet of said Southeast one-quarter, lying easterly of the easterly right of way line of Gas Point Road (County Road 1H01B); being APN 045-020-017.

13. Findings:

- a. The LEA has made a finding that this permit is consistent with the Shasta County Integrated Waste Management Plan, which was approved by the California Integrated Waste Management Board on October 22, 1997. The location of the facility is identified in the Countywide Siting Element, approved February 1996, pursuant to Public Resources Code (PRC), Section 50001(a).
- b. This permit is consistent with the standards adopted by CalRecycle, pursuant to PRC 44010.
- c. The design and operation of the facility is consistent with the State Minimum Standards for Solid Waste Handling and Disposal as determined by the Enforcement Agency, pursuant to PRC 44009.
- d. Final Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for a Proposed Sanitary Landfill Site (SCH#79021259) dated April 1980, with EIR Addendum November 1991, and Final EIR Addendum February 1992. In October 2003, a final EIR (SCH#2001112020) was certified with an Addendum, October 2014. These CEQA documents describe and support the design and operation which is authorized by this permit issuance.

14. Prohibitions:

The West Central Landfill is prohibited from accepting the following wastes:

Hazardous, radioactive, untreated medical (as defined in Chapter 6.1, Division 20 of the Health and Safety Code), liquid, designated, or other wastes requiring special treatment or handling, except as identified in the Report of Facility Information and approved amendments thereto and as approved by the enforcement agency and other federal, state, and local agencies.

16. Self Monitoring:

The owner/operator shall submit the results of all self monitoring programs to the Enforcement Agency within 30 days of the end of the reporting period. These reports shall be on-site and available for review.

f. Results of the landfill gas monitoring program.	Quarterly

h. Summary of groundwater monitoring and related reports.	Semi-Annually and Annually
i. Fill Sequencing Plan for the forthcoming year.	Annually-2 nd Quarterly Report

17. Enforcement Agency (EA) Conditions:

- a. The operator shall comply with all State Minimum Standards for solid waste handling and disposal as specified in Title 27 and Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations.
- b. The operator shall maintain a log of special/unusual occurrences. This log shall include, but is not limited to, fires, explosions, the discharge and disposition of hazardous or unpermitted wastes, and significant injuries, accidents or property damage. Each log entry shall be accompanied by a summary of any actions taken by the operator to mitigate the occurrence. The log shall be available to site personnel and the EA at all times.
- c. Additional information concerning the design and operation of the facility shall be furnished upon request and within the time frame specified by the EA.
- d. The maximum permitted daily tonnage for this facility is 700 tons per day and shall not receive more than this amount without a revision of this permit.
- e. The EA reserves the right to suspend or modify waste receiving and handling operations when deemed necessary due to an emergency, a potential health hazard, or the creation of a public nuisance.
- f. Any change that would cause the design or operation of the facility not to conform to the terms and conditions of this permit is prohibited. Such a change may be considered a significant change, requiring a permit revision. In no case shall the operator implement any change without first submitting a written notice of the proposed change, in the form of an RFI amendment, to the EA at least 180 days in advance of the change.
- g. A copy of this permit shall be maintained at the facility.
- h. The West Central Landfill is authorized to accept electronic waste, cathode ray tubes, metal, appliances, tires, and other materials as approved by the EA for recycling.
- i. The current Joint Technical Document, dated November 2014, describes the facility operations, plans, and supersedes any previously submitted site conditioning documents.
