37-AA-0929**12. Legal Description of Facility:**

1001 W. Bradley Avenue, El Cajon, San Diego County, CA 92020; Assessor Parcel Numbers 482-131-01 and 482-131-02; and as shown on Figure 2 of the Transfer Processing Report dated January 2014.

13. Findings:

- a) A County-wide Integrated Waste Management Plan was approved by the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) March 2011. Pursuant to Public Resource Code (PRC) §50001(b), this facility is not required to comply with PRC 50001. This solid waste facility is not a disposal facility or a transformation facility, nor a facility which is designed to, and which as a condition of its permit, will recover for reuse or recycling at least 5 percent of the total volume of material received as described in PRC §50001(a) paragraphs (1) and (2).
- b) The LEA has determined that the design of the facility would allow for the facility operations to be conducted in compliance with the State Minimum Standards for Solid Waste Transfer/Processing Operations and Facilities, based on a review of the January 2014 Transfer Processing Report and an inspection conducted on March 24, 2014.
- c) This permit is consistent with standards adopted by the CalRecycle, pursuant to Public Resources Code, §44010.
- d) The LEA has reviewed and considered the information regarding this facility contained in the Mitigated Negative Declaration (SCH No. 2008041011) adopted by the City of El Cajon Planning Commission on May 5, 2008. The LEA finds no significant unmitigable environmental effects arising out of the issuance of this Solid Waste Facility Permit.

14. Prohibitions:

The permittee is prohibited from accepting any liquid waste sludge, non-hazardous waste requiring special handling, designated waste, hazardous waste, biohazardous waste, waste containing more than 50% water, friable and non-friable asbestos, large dead animals or parts thereof, and radioactive waste.

16. LEA Conditions:

- a) The operator shall comply with all the State Minimum Standards for solid waste handling.
- b) The operator shall maintain a copy of this permit, the Transfer Processing Report (TPR), and a copy of or access to State Minimum Standards for Transfer/Processing Stations at the site at all times.
- c) Without prior written or verbal approval from the LEA to allow otherwise, the facility may only operate as described in the most current version of the TPR.
- d) This permit is subject to review by the LEA and may be temporarily suspended or revoked at any time by the LEA for sufficient cause, in accordance with Division 30 of the PRC, Part 4, Chapter 4, Article 2, Sections 44305 et seq.
- e) Any change that would cause the design or operation of the facility not to conform to the terms and conditions of this permit is prohibited. Such change may be considered a significant change, requiring a permit revision. In no case shall the operator implement changes without first submitting a written notice of the proposed change, in the form of a Report of Facility Information amendment, to the LEA at least 180 days in advance of the proposed change.

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16. LEA Conditions: Continued

- f) Stored recyclables shall not interfere with facility operations or cause a public nuisance as determined by the LEA. The maximum storage time for salvaged or recycled material shall not exceed 90 days (TPR Section 5.4.3). The LEA reserves the right to reduce the maximum storage time of recyclables as necessary to protect public health or prevent a nuisance.
- g) The operator shall maintain, and keep current, records of weight and types of waste received per day. Co-mingled and non-source separated recyclables shall be counted toward total daily tonnage. These records shall include the final disposition of transferred waste and recycled materials.
- h) Additional information related to compliance with this permit or the design and operation of this facility shall be furnished to the LEA upon request.
